

Re.S.P.I.R.O Project

Summary of the project

The project aims to support co-operation among private and public organizations and to strengthen / enlarge networks in order to share best practises concerning new economical strategies or innovative technical managements to prevent criminality.

Particularly, the purpose is focusing on social and working inclusion measures, therefore on services and support realities for the transition to work as tools of criminality prevention, relapses included.

Attention is paid to intervene in strong uneasiness situations where a quick answer can sensibly reduce number and gravity of crimes and, therefore, the impact on civil society systems. That either towards young people, preventing deviance risk, or towards adults, offering opportunity to avoid crime reiteration also because of difficulties to follow lawful programs for support and active society participation.

The project will act on 3 levels:

EUROPEAN, to link in a network or permanent net even after the end of the project, public institutions and social private bodies, feeding the institutional dialogue and among practises, among different countries (in total 17 partners, of which 6 Public bodies and 11 private ones)

NATIONAL, to consolidate with programmatic agreements the collaboration among public and social private and among different local nets with the aim of favouring the transfer of good practises, through a national Technical Committee of the sector;

LOCAL, to activate new relations among the local systems which favour the agreed planning of the prevention of criminality through social and working inclusion.

The project involves public and private nets of France, Spain, Romania and Denmark while, on a national scale, project partners are Piedmont Region, Lombardy Region, Justice Superintendency of Lombardy, Milan Province and Bologna Municipality.

More than 350 operators will be directly involved (on average 30 operators for each involved region).

Briefly, project actions will be:

- research and analysis of case studies belonging to important experiences of Italy, France and Spain, including the legislative framework
- creation of a model of best practices to support social and working inclusion to prevent criminality and relapses.
- creation of a sector Technical Scientific Committee which will be the supervisor of the study activities and the transfer of best practises models in order to carry out a national project mainstreaming.
- creation and strengthening of a local network in order to strengthen communication among the involved organizations and istitutions, to understand the reference legislative framework; to identify best practises in local realities considering their opportunity of sharing.
- Creation of an interregional and international Network of share/cooperation beetween partners and operators on european, national and regional scale.
